Re: Dunns Road upgrade works

Wagga Wagga City Council is undertaking an \$8.3 million project to upgrade and bitumen seal the full length of Dunns Road including intersection upgrades at the Olympic Highway and Holbrook Road.

Procurement of major drainage pipes has occurred with delivery expected in December 2022. In the meantime, preliminary works are underway and include relocating communication services, tree pruning and renewal of some minor transverse drainage pipes along the unsealed segment of the road.

The replacement of the minor transverse drainage work will be carried out between 7am and 5pm, from Wednesday 13 to Friday October 15, 2021, weather permitting. Dunns Road will be reduced to one lane during these times with traffic control in place to manage traffic flow.

The major construction work is planned to commence during January 2022. The work will be carried out in three stages:

- Stage 1 – Upgrade to the unsealed section of Dunns Road to a continuous bitumen sealed road
- Stage 2 – Upgrade the Olympic Highway / Dunns Road intersection to include a dedicated right turn lane
- Stage 3 – Construction of a roundabout at the Dunns Road / Holbrook Road / Lloyd Road intersection

Stage 1 of the works will be undertaken utilising in-house Council resources. Stage 2 and 3 works will be undertaken by contractors following completion of Stage 1.

During the Stage 1 major construction work, Dunns Road will be closed to through traffic to ensure the safety of members of the public and allow the works to be undertaken as efficiently and effectively as possible. Further notification concerning road closures will be provided at least 2 weeks in advance of the commencement of the major works.

This project is funded by the Australian Federal Government and Wagga Wagga City Council.
